Question 1: Request an extension of time to the EOI

The EOI closing date is now extended to 12:00pm AEDT time, on Friday 4 February 2022. The new closing date and the associated key dates have been updated on the EOI web site.

The key dates are now:

- Expressions of Interest close at 12:00pm, AEDT, Friday 4 February 2022
- Q & A lodgement closes at 12:00pm, AEDT, Friday 28 January 2022
- You can expect to hear the outcome of your expression of interest by mid-February 2022
- Selected applicants will be invited to submit a request for proposal by 5:00pm AEDT on 28 February 2022
- The successful applicant is expected to be announced by March 2022.

Question 2: Can you clarify how the mandatory requirements of a "... minimum two years' experience scaling and growing cyber security businesses..." would be assessed would sector-agnostic accelerator experience be considered?

In assessing against this requirement, in the absence of direct experience, the Panel will take into account transferable experience such as accelerator delivery experience focused on growing and scaling businesses in other sectors or sector-agnostic. We encourage respondents to elaborate how their experience will be transferable to support the goals and outcomes in the cyber security industry (on page 6 of the EOI document), including the context of specific market challenges that cyber businesses may face.
